This day of Princess pampering for both foster and non-foster girls will include a tea party lunch, spa treatment, a photo shoot and a complete princess outfit that will be theirs to keep.

The event is sponsored by A Family for Every Child, a local non-profit adoption agency, and is designed as a gift for foster children in the community as well as to raise awareness of foster children in Lane County.

Quote: "This is a perfect time for both girls and foster girls to enjoy a day of pampering and celebration." Every girl should be accompanied by an adult guest. Each princess will receive their own tiara, a princess gown and princess slippers. She will also get her nails and hair done for a perfect photograph. Lunch and a tea party will be provided for both the girl and her adult guest.

The cost of this event is \$50, but foster children and their guests are admitted free with advance registration.

A Family for Every Child was started by Christy Obie-Barrett, the mother of 12 children, 9 of whom are adopted. Christy was looking for a way to make a difference in the lives of more children. So in January of 2006, A Family for Every Child was incorporated as a not for profit business in Oregon. During the next six months, A Family for Every Child, was formed and developed into an organization that focuses on finding permanent loving homes for Oregon's waiting children. Its intention is to develop programs that assist special needs/hard to place foster children in finding their own forever families.
