Why Should We Commit To Family Finding?

- Every child has a family.
- Loneliness can be devastating, and particularly felt by foster children.
 - Meaningful connections to family help children develop a sense of belonging.
- The single most identified factor contributing to positive outcomes for children involves meaningful connections and lifelong relationships with family.

Family Finding recognizes that families are disempowered by the placement of relative children outside of the family system, and it seeks to remediate that harm through identifying the strengths and assets of each family member and facilitate processes through which families are able to effectively support their relative children.

Children in relative foster care tend to be just as safe as or safer than children placed with non-relative foster families.
