



Matching Assistance is a password protected site with additional child listings, helping support qualified, current home studied families during their journey to adoption.

Every day children's case workers search for suitable homes for hundreds of foster kid's nationwide. In this search, they are looking at parenting qualifications such as parent training and education, ability to accommodate special needs, and family background and situation.

Having your profile, narrative, home study, and possibly a video ready for a searching case worker greatly increases the chance that you will be selected as a potential family for a waiting child. You don't need extraordinary equipment to provide these to us. Pertinent, honest, and entertaining family photos can be taken with an ordinary digital camera and uploaded via the internet to the Family Website. The profile consists of information about how to reach you, your situation, and your parenting experiences. Your home study is kept confidential.

### **Matching Assistance**

*The matching assistance option supports your family, by assigning a family adoption specialist during your journey to adoption as well as someone who reviews your family materials and gives you perspective and suggestions for your family profile. We will update and follow up on the children you submit on.*

#### **Here are the following benefits to this option:**

You will be assigned your own **FAMILY ADOPTION SPECIALIST** that searches for you, follows up and helps you submit on kids all over the country.

A "**REVIEWER**" that reads your family biography and homestudy documents to give you perspective and suggestions for your family profile.

You get to **CREATE A FAMILY BIOGRAPHY PAGE** to help communicate the strengths of your family and use images to tell your story.

**ACCESS TO IN DEPTH INFORMATION ON ADOPTION**, new photo-listing sites, creating a life book, services, trainings and more from within the log on site.

You get **ADVANCED** email notices of '**KIDS IN NEED EMAILS.**' We usually send these out when a child is in urgent need, and caseworkers are really ready to move quickly. The MAP families get 24 advance notices of these situations.

You get **WEEKLY EMAIL NEWSLETTERS** geared toward the MAP program.

Families get access to a "**ADDITIONAL CHILD LISTING**" of children, many more kids can be listed on a protected site than are on the public web site. Children listed, are from all over the United States. These children are conveniently located in one place for easy review and home-study submission.

And, you get to **SUBMIT FOR YOURSELF**, with a link to a family profile page and extra information you would like to share.

*This option gives families the ability to show caseworkers their personality and character through pictures and a bio page. You are **NOT** assigned a family adoption specialist and your worker is responsible for follow up on any inquiries and submissions on children.*
