Custom Submit

Our customized submission process has become one of our most valuable assets to organizations and families utilizing our site. We now have the ability to program processes specific to state, county, organization, or worker. We can program an auto response informing families of any requests you require before accepting a homestudy, we can intercept homestudies to attach required information, or hold the study pending approval to be sent. We can also redirect our families awaiting the redirect information from your organization.

Photo Listing

We can feature children on our *public photolisting website*. Approximately 500 home studies are submitted through our automated system every week.

Children with public photo listing average an additional 15+ home study submissions than non-public listing.

We have additional options available, such as in-state, regional or national listings for homestudy approved families.

MAP for Professionals

(Matching Assistance Program)

The Matching Assistance Program (MAP) is a FREE password protected membership program with additional child listings, helping support homestudy-approved families who are seeking to adopt from foster care.

MAP works alongside families, their adoption workers, and children's social workers during the "matching" phase of the adoption process, connecting waiting families with children. Our Professionals membership allows Caseworkers to request recruitment services for children on your caseload, quickly photo list a child for in-state or nationwide families to submit on, and conduct targeted family searches for children on your caseload based on specific family characteristics. Social Workers can submit a family's home study directly to a child's case worker, message a child's caseworker via our private messaging system, and view child submissions made by your adoptive families.

Child Matching Events

For families nationwide to find the perfect child to join their family! We average around 40 families attending each event. This is a unique and innovative way to share information about waiting children to the many families nationwide that are searching for children they can be forever families for. Families are much more likely to become interested in a child after they've seen pictures and videos that represent the child's personality, and after they've heard about the child's behaviors directly from one of the people that knows the child the best; their social worker.

Family Matching Events

For social workers nationwide, to find the perfect family for all their foster children! On average, four families are featured during each event. These events allow Families to present themselves and their lifestyle in their own words and give social workers the ability to ask questions anonymously to better grasp if they may be a good fit for a child on their caseload. After the event, you can request to view any family's home study.

Online Matching Events utilize easy, simple and accessible technology to portray foster children.

Family Finding

Family Finding is a process that reconnects children with family members and other lost loved ones with the purpose of supporting youth in foster care. This “support” can be demonstrated in a number of ways, including placement, respite care, visitation, knowledge, and support post foster care. By engaging positive relatives, friends, and community members, foster children are given a support team that goes beyond their foster parents and case staff. With the use of Family Finding, foster youth not only are reconnected with healthy contacts, but have the opportunity to learn about their roots.
